



## Registered Clinical Psychotherapist (RCP) application guide

This guide details eligibility criteria and provides a preview of the questions you will be required to answer when submitting your online application form. If you have any questions, please email [membership@pacfa.org.au](mailto:membership@pacfa.org.au).

Please note: this is **not** an application form. To apply, please fill in the online application form, and email your supporting documents to [membership@pacfa.org.au](mailto:membership@pacfa.org.au).

### Eligibility criteria:

- You **must** be an existing Clinical PACFA member
- You must have completed a course(s) with a minimum of 450 hours direct training contact (theory and practice) in psychotherapy
- All training included in your RCP application **must be additional to the training undertaken to join PACFA originally**. The first 400 hours of training included in your initial PACFA application cannot be used again for the 450 hours required in psychotherapy to gain the RCP title.
- You must have completed 200 hours of supervised client contact during training (maximum 50% of the supervision may come from group supervision of no more than six group members)
- You must have completed 150 hours of personal psychotherapy, either within or concurrently with training

### Documents required for application:

- Prepare a written case study of a long-term client - approximately 1000 words in length, with a pseudonym used and any identifying information removed to protect client confidentiality
- Prepare a written description of your own psychotherapy training, philosophy, and practice experience
- Provide copies of your transcript(s) and graduation certificate(s) for each course included in the application
